- 1. A regular meeting of the City Council of Postville, Iowa, in the Council Chambers at 147 N. Lawler St. on December 11, 2023, beginning at 7:00 p.m. with Dennis Koenig presiding.
- 2. On call of the roll, the following Council Members were present: Rebecca Engelhardt, Mary Engstrom, Ross Malcom, Devora Klein-Mahr and Larry Moore. Absent: None.
- 3. Council Member Englehardt made a motion to approve the **agenda** as posted by the Clerk. Seconded by Engstrom. Carried 5:0.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance.

- 4. Mayor Koenig administered the **oath of office** to Larry Moore and Laurie Moody.
- 5. Discussion was held on parking along the designated **truck route**. Currently there is parking allowed on the south side of the street of Lybrand. The council will take the matter into consideration.
- 6. Crystal Duffy and Devora Klein-Mahr address the council with the idea of a **Council Connection** at the Postville Public Library where a council member will be present on Thursdays from 4:30 to 5 p.m. to meet with the public and address any suggestion or concerns in the community. There are other ways citizens can connect by email; or leaving a message in the connection notebook at the library. Duffy stated she will begin giving notice to the public about this new opportunity to connect.
