REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF POSTVILLE, IOWA February 12, 2024

- 1. A regular meeting of the City Council of Postville, Iowa, in the Council Chambers at 147 N. Lawler St. on February 12, 2024, beginning at 7:00 p.m. with Dennis Koenig presiding.
- 2. On call of the roll, the following Council Members were present: Larry Moore, Devora Klein-Mahr, Laurie Moody, Mary Engstrom and Rebecca Engelhardt. Absent: None.
- 3. Council Member Engstrom made a motion to approve the **agenda** as posted by the Clerk. Seconded by Moore. Carried 5:0.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance.

- 4. Paul Kruse, PMA Financial Network LLC, addressed the council via phone to explain the **Iowa Public Agency Investment Trust**, a comprehensive cash management service for Iowa Cities, Counties and City Utilities. The investment account is a high interest money market account, doesn't cost anything, provides an investment option for liquid funds, can be a good barometer for rates in Iowa, gets certificate of deposit rates from outside area banks, an option for funds when local banks do not want public funds, diversification, laddering of bond proceeds during construction phase, bank philosophies/ ownership can change, ability to have unlimited accounts with daily access, online investment capabilities and reporting, and if utilized benefits the sponsoring association. Council Member Engelhardt made a motion to adopt **Resolution #1418-24** A Resolution Authorizing the Iowa Public Agency Investment Trust Agreement. Seconded by Moody. The roll was called ayes: Moore, Mahr, Moody, Engstrom and Engelhardt. Nays: None. Carried 5:0.
- 5. Public Hearing on **261 W. Stoneman** no bids were received for the property.
- 6. Council Member Engstrom made a motion to adopt **Resolution #1416-24** A Resolution requesting fund for Educational Program with Winneshiek County Solid Waste Agency. Seconded by Moore. The roll was called ayes: Moore, Mahr, Moody, Engstrom and Engelhardt. Nays: None. Carried 5:0.
- Council Member Mahr made a motion to table Ordinance #695-24 An Ordinance Amending Chapter 15 (Mayor) and Chapter 17 (Council) of the Postville, Iowa Code of Ordinances. Seconded by Engelhardt. Ayes: Moore, Mahr, Moody, Engstrom and Engelhardt. Carried 5:0.
- 8. The council members reviewed the **council policy/procedures** manual. Mayor Koenig informed the council he will give them more time for review will place on the March 11, 2024 agenda.
- 9. The council reviewed the current **purchasing policy**. The Council directed the clerk to change the allowable amount that requires council approval prior to purchase from \$500 to \$1000. Council will take action by resolution at the March 11, 2024 meeting.
- 10. The city budget FY 24/25 was reviewed the tax rate for FY 24/25 will be set at 15.35128. Council Member Mahr made a motion to adopt **Resolution #1419-24** A Resolution Setting Time and Place for Public Hearing for the Purpose of Soliciting Written and Oral Comments on the City's Proposed Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Budget. Seconded by Engstrom. The roll was called ayes: Moore, Mahr, Moody, Engstrom and Engelhardt. Nays: None. Carried 5:0.
- 11. Council reviewed three bids for a **police K-9 vehicle** replacement for the 2024/2025 budget. Police Chief Ellis recommended the Ford Explorer due to the room needed for the K-9 equipment. Council Member Moore made a motion to proceed with the Ford Explorer model and get pricing for equipment with respective dealers and lead time for the total vehicle package. Seconded by Moody. Carried 5:0.
- 12. Council Member Engelhardt made a motion to approve the bid of **Iroc Web Design** to update the city website in the amount of \$3,375. Seconded by Engstrom. Carried 5:0.
- 13. Discussion was held on changing **Cheryl Street** to a one way with traffic flowing north from Lybrand to Cheryl. No action taken.
- 14. Council Member Engelhardt made a motion to approve the **consent agenda**

Pursuant to Iowa Code 364.7 The procedure requires the City Council to set forth its proposal to sell the property in a resolution and publish notice of a public hearing on the proposal.
